Kelmscott's Hidden Coffee will set the scene of an alternative live music venue more usually found in the inner city hubs. Each Friday of the Festival will showcase great local bands, hip hop artists and musicians.

On the Festival's opening night, **Friday 11 May**, Indie Rock will take centre stage, with acoustic artist **Tim Reese**, popular local bands **The Skelton Collective** and **Hibiscus** as well as emerging band **James Dylan & The Sadmen**.

On **Friday 18 May**, the vibe will be taken up a notch with a focus on Hip Hop. **Tobias, Ruben Proud, Colin Myer Swan** and **Salekt Faw** will take the centre stage with some special guests making a surprise appearance on the night.

The final night of music at Hidden Coffee will see alternative and electronic music from industrial to shoegaze. **Axoloti, MotET** and **Yomi Ship** will feature.

Minnawarra Chapel will set the scene for captivating concerts delivered by the Armadale Musicians Network during the Live at the Chapel series hosted throughout the Armadale Arts Festival.

Whether you're a fan of Celtic music, a lover of the accordion, or just fancy taking in the majestic sounds of a gong and Hang drum, Live at the Chapel promises to deliver some memorable Festival moments.

Roleystone based **Chris Horgan** will kick off Live at the Chapel on **Sunday 13 May** from 5 to 6.30pm, performing a special Mother's Day concert of ancient tunes played on handmade acoustic woodwind instruments including the Irish wooden flute, uilleann pipes and whistles.

On **Saturday 19 May** there are two performances from 2 to 3pm and 5 to 6pm - local musicians from **Classics Sounds Orchestra** will be joined by accordion maestro **Cathie Travers**.

The final Live in the Chapel on **Saturday 26 May** from 4 to 5.30pm will feature Armadale local **Paul Ford** playing gong joined by **Eugene McGrath** who will play his melodic Hang drum.
