



2022 Armadale Arts Festival Artist

Call for Nominations

The City of Armadale is calling for nominations for the 2022 Armadale Arts Festival Artist. People can nominate an arts practitioner in any field (e.g. visual art, performing arts, music, literature, etc), and are encouraged to develop the nomination in consultation with the person they are nominating. Alternatively arts practitioners can self-nominate.

The honorary Festival Artist appointment acknowledges the accomplishments of a particular arts practitioner each year and celebrates the valued contribution that local artists bring to the Armadale community. The successful Festival Artist will be invited to act as an ambassador for the Armadale Arts Festival to be held in May 2022.

The Festival Artist responsibilities include:

- Writing a welcome statement for inclusion in the official Festival program
- Providing an artist bio and photo
- Presenting a speech at the Festival opening function (date TBC)
- Being available for media interviews about their own arts practice and the local arts community

There is the possibility for the 2022 Festival Artist or the Festival Artist network to receive support from the City of Armadale to develop a community arts project that contributes to the local cultural identity. This is subject to further discussion and may be guided by the interest and vision of the selected Festival Artist.

Nominations close at 5pm on Sunday 5 December 2021.

A panel made up of previous Festival Artists and City of Armadale staff will consider all nominations received by the due date. Nominations will be assessed in relation to: arts practice, community contribution, local connection and suitability as an ambassador.

Nominations will not be made public, and the panel's decision is final. The 2022 Festival Artist will be announced prior to the Armadale Arts Festival.
